Early college high schools

Early College High Schools provide a unique opportunity for traditionally underserved students to earn a high school diploma and two years of college credit, which can be applied toward an associate's or bachelor's degree. The Early College High School concept was formed around the successes of small high schools (learning communities), dual credit programs, and rigorous curriculum. The design of early college high schools is intended not only to increase high school graduation tolls but also to raise the level of college-readiness, particularly among minority and low-income youth. In addition to preparing students for college academically, Early College High Schools reduce the time and the money ultimately needed to earn a postsecondary degree (Gates Foundation, 2006).

Early College High Schools provee una unica oportunidad para que estudiantes obtengan su diploma de High School y a la misma vez obtengan crédito por dos años de colegio que puede ser aplicado para un titulo de universidad de dos o cuatro años. El concepto de Early College High School fue formado por el éxito de escuelas de High School (Comunidades de Aprendizaje), programas de doble crédito, y un riguroso programa de enseñanza. El diseño de Early College High Schools no es solamente para aumentar el índice de graduación, sino tambien para aumentar el nivel de preparación para el colegio, particularmente entre minorías y jovenes de bajos ingresos. Ademas de preparar académicamente a estudiantes para el colegio, Early College Hig Schools reduce el tiempo y dinero que se necesita para obtener un titulo de Colegio (Gates Foundation, 2006).

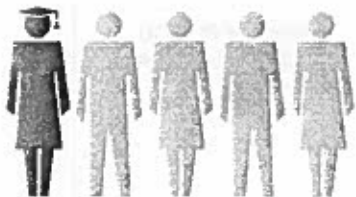


- U.S. jobs that will require a post-secondary education in the year 2020.

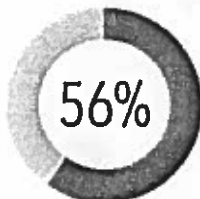


- Number of potential college credits students can earn in collegiate academies.



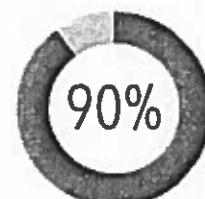
- One in five early college students graduate high school with a college degree.

- Early college students who are the first in their families to attend college.

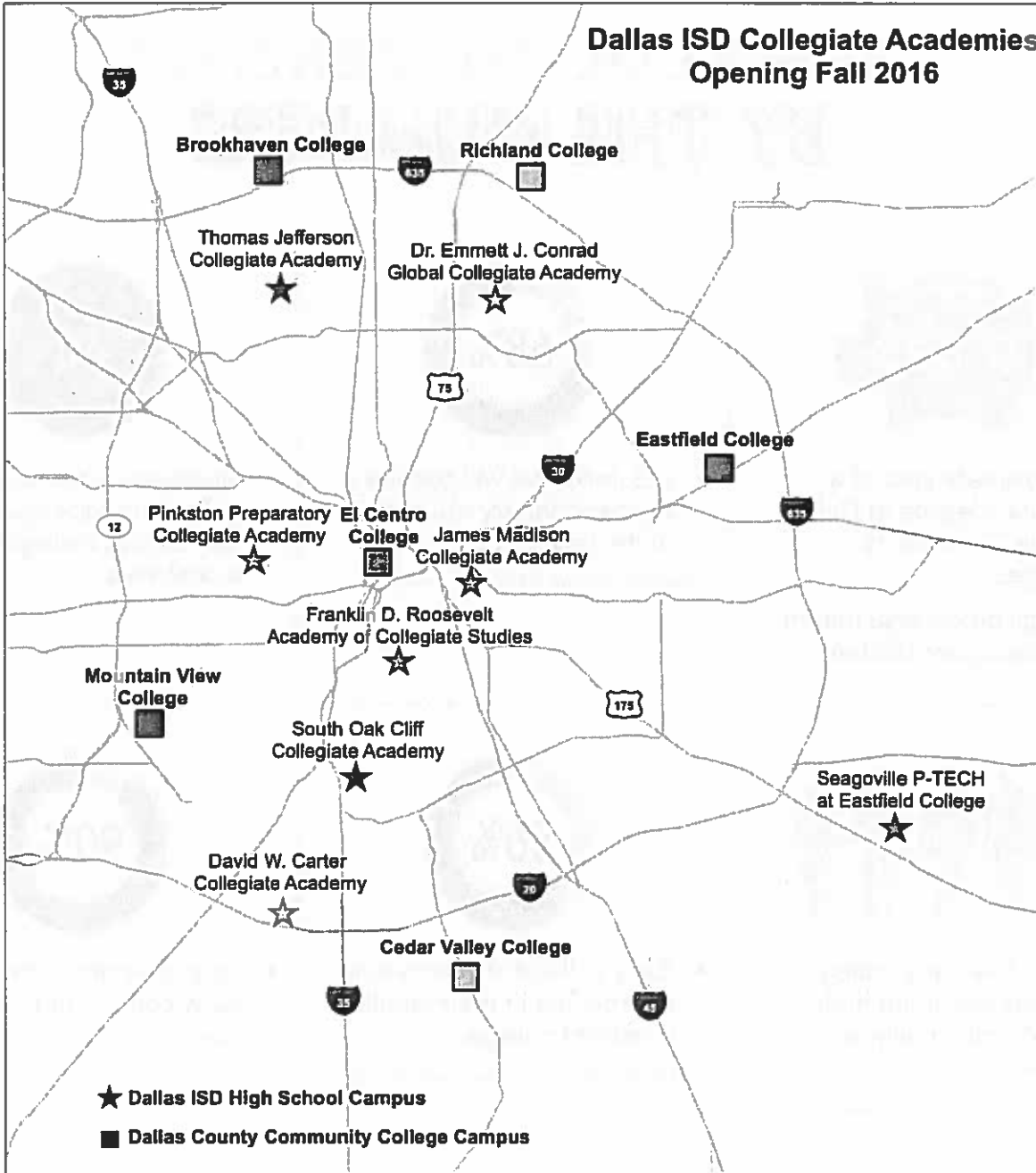
